The Corporation (SNTCA, established April 29, 2009) was organized to amend the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, and provide a \$5,000 refundable tax credit, for low and moderate income individuals, for legal expenses incurred to become guardian of an individual with disabilities.

On March 2, 2011, Congressman Ted Deutch (FL-19th Cong. District), introduced House Resolution 878, and on April 2, 2013, reintroduced the Bill as HR 1597, the **Special Needs Tax Credit Act.**

Purpose: "To amend the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 to provide a credit to individuals for legal expenses paid with respect to establishing guardianship of a disabled individual."

Passage of this congressional legislation will enable a qualified individual an affordable means to become legal guardian for a person with disabilities, one who may not be able to speak conscientiously for themselves in legal, financial and health care matters.

I support House Resolution 1597, to assist persons with disabilities enjoy a more protected and rewarding quality of life. My signature attests to my support for this legislation and desire for my elected representative in Congress to support passage of this legislation.
